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### MIDWIFERY CURRICULUM TOPICS

1. **“Healthy Woman’s and Man’s Reproductive Health”** (First year midwifery students with no clinical experience)
  - 1.1 Factors influencing sexual and reproductive health.
  - 1.2. Anatomy of female reproductive tract, maternal pelvis and breast.
  - 1.3. Physiological processes of human reproduction, incl. ovogenesis, spermatogenesis, menstruation cycle and factors influencing them.
  - 1.4. Preconception care
2. **“Gynaecological Diseases: midwifery care in case of gynaecological problems”** (Third year students have clinical experience in normal pregnancy and delivery and postnatal care. They have passed compulsory prerequisites: internal diseases and surgical nursing care)
  - 2.1. Common gynaecological diseases- oncological and sexually transmitted infections.
  - 2.2. Pregnancy loss and abortion care- methods, legislation, counselling.
  - 2.3. Infertility- treatment and legislation.
  - 2.4. Emergencies in gynaecology, triage in women’s clinic emergency department and telephone.
  - 2.5. Menopause- approach, treatment”
3. **“Clinical Psychology”**
  - 3.1. Maternal Mental health
  - 3.2. Psychological Changes during pregnancy and the postnatal period.
  - 3.3. Techniques of therapeutic communication as nurse's and midwife's role in applying the techniques in practice.
4. **“Art and Science in Midwifery”** (Forth year students have clinical experience in normal and high risk pregnancy and nursing skills, intrapartum and postnatal care. They have passed compulsory prerequisites: internal diseases and surgical nursing care, gyneacology, intensive care nursing)
  - 4.1.The origins of research in midwifery.
  - 4.2. Midwives imago in society, media.
  - 4.3. Representation of birth and midwives in art. 4.4. Challenges in providing evidence based care.
