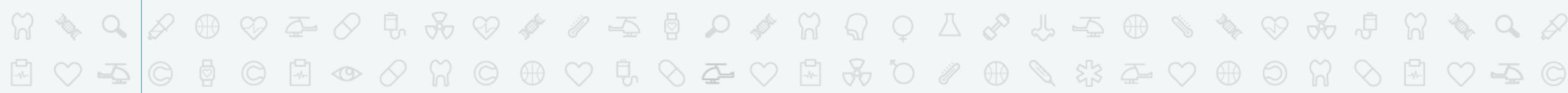

- In 2018 the college has approximately 1900 students (Master's level - 60, higher education - 1464, vocational education - 433) and 140 employees



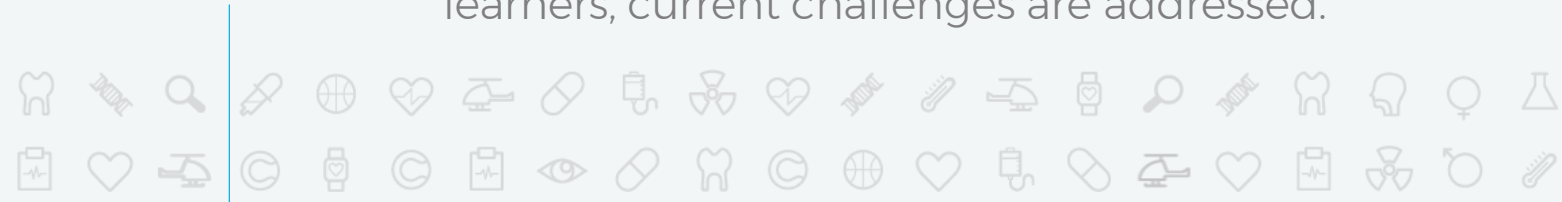
Mission and Vision

- **Mission**

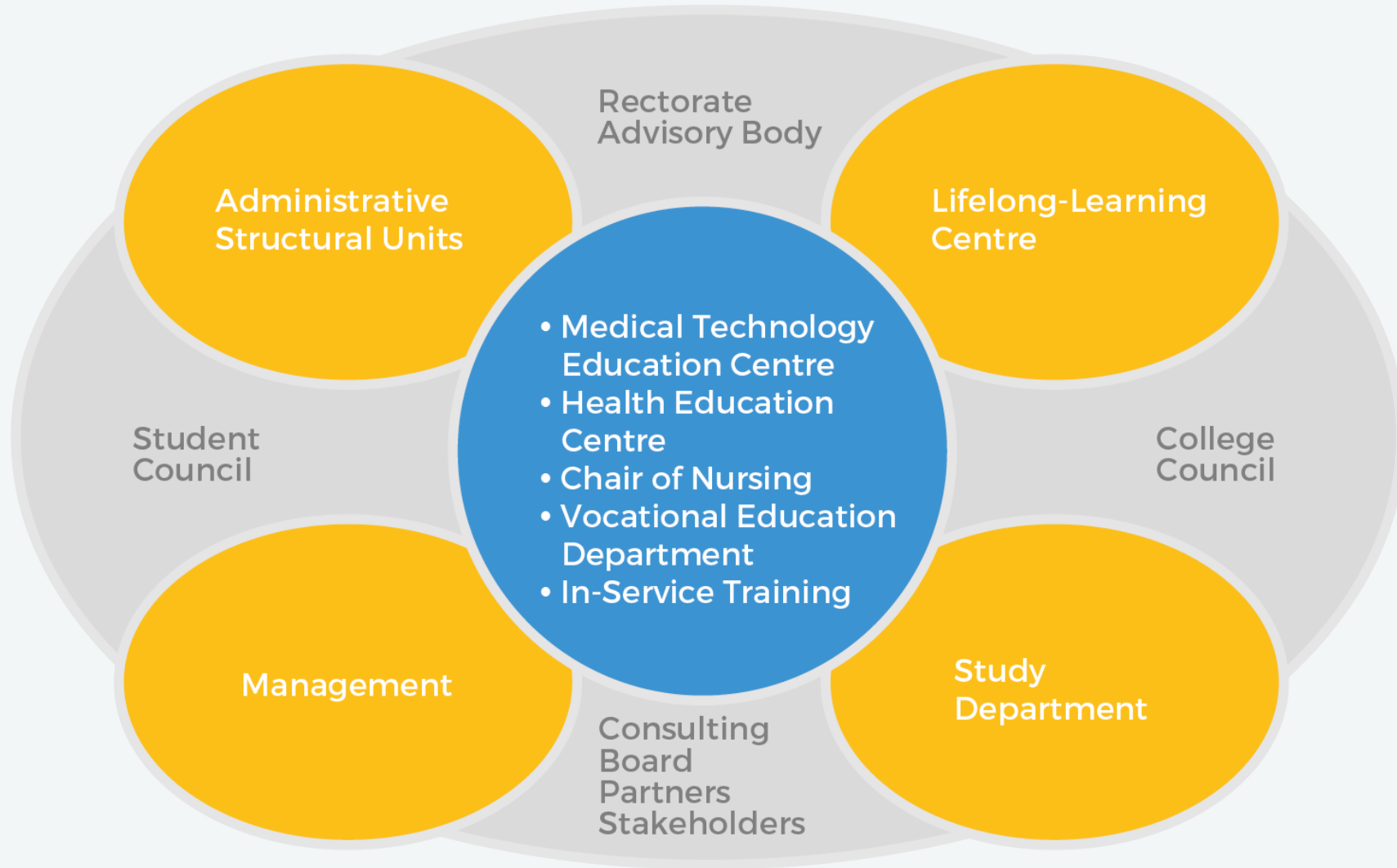
The College trains innovatively and critically thinking health professionals with technological competences.

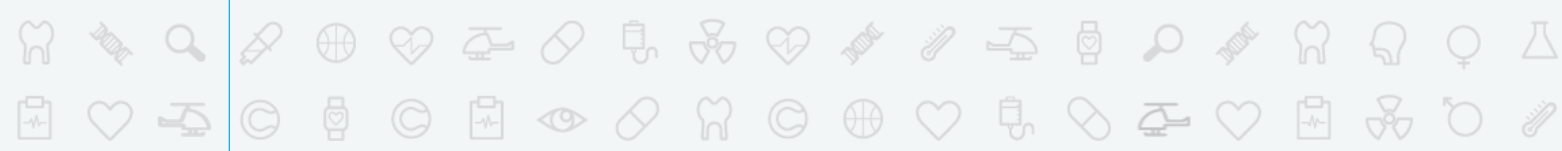

Important Dates

- **1940** – Tallinn Medical School was founded
- **2002** – Nursing education studies (for nurses with previous vocational education) started in Kohtla-Järve Medical School
- **2005** – Tallinn Medical School became a higher education institution and was renamed Tallinn Health Care College
- **2006** – Kohtla-Järve Medical School became a structural unit of Tallinn Health Care College
- **2007** – studies started in Pärnu Hospital
- **October, 16** – anniversary of Tallinn Health Care College



Accreditations and External Evaluations

- **2012 - Institutional Accreditation**

The Quality Assessment Council of the Estonian Higher Education Quality Agency decided to accredit Tallinn Health Care College for **7 years**.

- **2015 - Accreditation of Vocational Education**

The Quality Assessment Council of the Estonian Higher and Vocational Education Quality Agency decided to accredit Tallinn Health Care College health and social services curriculum for **6 years**.

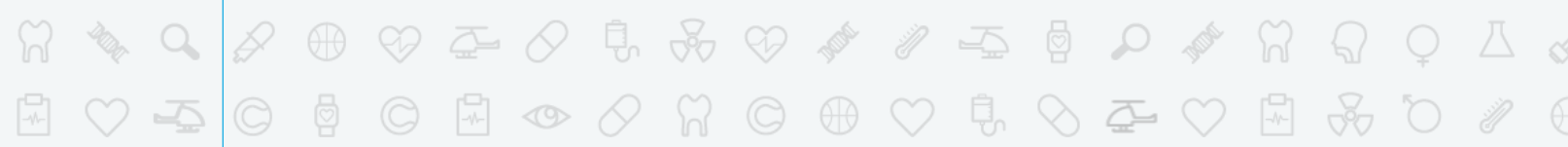
- **2016 - Quality Assessment**

The Quality Assessment Council for Higher Education of the Estonian Quality Agency for Higher Education and VET decided to approve the report by the Assessment Committee and to conduct the next quality assessment of the Medicine study programme group in the first cycle of higher education in **7 years**, and of the Health Care study programme group in the first cycle of higher education at Tallinn Health Care College in **7 years**, with a secondary condition.



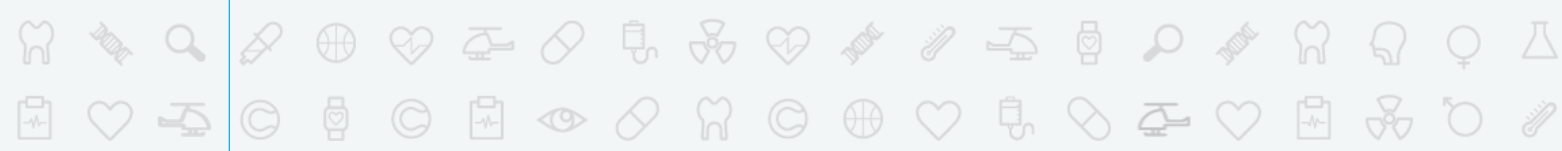
Master's, Programmes of Higher Education

- **Health Sciences Master's Degree** – 1,5 years
- **General Nurse** – 3,5 years
- **Midwife**– 4,5 years
- **Optometrist** – 3,5 years
- **Assistant Pharmacist** – 3 years
- **Dental Technician** – 3,5 years
- **Occupational Therapist** – 4 years
- **Health Promotion** – 3 years

Pärnu Hospital

- Nursing studies in Pärnu Hospital started in 2007 – firstly for nurses with previous vocational education
- In 2014 Tallinn Health Care College, Pärnu Hospital, Estonian Nurses Union and Pärnu College signed a joint project titled “College in the Hospital”
- Aim of the project: to provide the possibility to study nursing in higher education close to home
- First study group started in 2014 – 31 students
- Second and third study groups started in 2017 and 2018 – 30 students + 30 students



Practical Training

- Practical training forms 30-50% of the studies
- Wide network of practical placements all over Estonia
- Individual support is provided by the mentor at the practical placement, supervisor at the college and the tutor student

Incoming: students and staff mobility

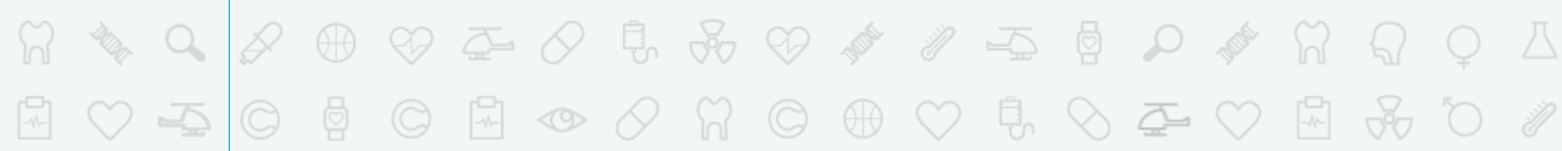


Outgoing: students and staff mobility
